

Landscape Curb Specifications

In an effort to standardize the use of concrete landscape edging in the VML community, the BOD has approved the following specifications for use of extruded concrete landscape edging by VML residents:

The approved edging prototype is provided by Curb Ease and is their Peak Profile, brick pattern, as shown. The overall size is approximately 6 inches wide and 4 inches high and must be installed on the ground and not on top of the brick or other mulch. The front edge of the profile is to be at the same height as the lawn. It will provide a clean edge to plant beds, retain the original outline of the bed and help stop window damage from flying brick chips. Use of concrete curbing is approved **ONLY** for landscape beds.

Owners may use any contractor they like that can provide the curb profile specified. While there are many color choices, a color that harmonizes and matches the house brick should be selected.

NOTE: Concrete edging/curbing will **NOT** be approved along driveways and sidewalks.

The amount of edging/curbing to be installed needs to be part of the impervious square footage calculation.
